The Southampton African American Museum is the East End's destination for preserving and promoting African American culture. Established in 2021, the museum is the restored "The Barbershop" — an iconic local gathering place for Blacks in the late 40's., as well as that of "Fives" — a restaurant and juke joint — the other iconic establishment where locals who were part of the Great Migration.



Ma's House located on the Shinnecock Reservation, is a communal art space for Black, Indigenous and People of Color (BIPOC). The project, which began in June 2020, provides a shared art studio, along with an array of art and history-based educational program for triable members and the broader community.
